





Christmas Rules



Coronavirus is spreading quickly. Boris Johnson has changed the Christmas Rules for people living in England.



People in England will need to follow the rules for their local tier. **The tiers have changed. There are four tiers.**

Some people can have a support bubble. Support bubbles are allowed in all tiers.




There are some different rules only for Christmas Day.



Coronavirus - England

Christmas in Tiers 1, 2 and 3



We need to think very carefully about seeing people from other households on Christmas Day. We need to try to stay safe and healthy.



People in tier 1, 2 and 3 can choose to make a Christmas Bubble. **A Christmas Bubble is 3 households that only see each other on Christmas day. You cannot see people in tier 4.**



If you are in a support bubble already, then you count as 1 household.



If you have a Christmas bubble you should try to:

- Stay local
- Visit fewer people
- Keep any visits short
- Wash your hands regularly
- Keep windows open



It is safer to video call or telephone people important to you.



Coronavirus - England Christmas in Tier 4




1 Boris Johnson announced a new tier to try and stop coronavirus spreading very quickly in some areas. This is Tier 4 and it is similar to 'lockdown'.



People in Tier 4 cannot make Christmas Bubbles. **On Christmas Day you can see people in your household or support bubble.**



You can only visit other households if they are part of your support bubble.



You are allowed to meet one person from a different household in a public place. You should stay 2 metres away. **You should not travel outside of your tier.**



You can video call or telephone people important to you.
