

The bridge

- Built 1826, Grade II* listed
- 17,000 vehicles a day

The works

- £3.9m funding from government
- Repairs to concrete truss, deck, refurb of arches & parapets




Works programme

- 19th April: 2 way traffic signals on the bridge (off-peak)
- 10th May 6th August: bridge closed to all traffic
- 9th August 31st October: occasional use of 2 way traffic signals


Other disruption in Bath 2021


- May: several overnight closures of A3604 Windsor Bridge
- 7th August 9th Sept: rail line between Bath Spa and Bristol Temple Meads closed
- 6th Sept 9th Nov (provisional): A367 Corn Street closed to westbound traffic between jcts with Avon Street and Ambury.







- Advisory signing deterring use of Camden Road
- Parking restrictions approaching Batheaston Toll Bridge
- Back-up plans
- Traffic signals & urban traffic control system
- Traffic cameras
- Live Link to satnavs, Google Maps, Apple Maps & Waze
