- □ To complete the national PCN toolkit templates and undertake a gap analysis using the latest SHAPE Atlas to ensure completeness and accuracy of the primary care data held to enable informed decisions to be made. This will include for each locality, a mapping of wider health and care estate infrastructure, as well as third sector to ensure an integrated approach and optimal utilisation of local estate.
- A core offer for PCNs focused on organisational and skills development, supporting groups of PCNs at a locality level to further develop their service and estate strategies in collaboration with local partners, taking a population health management approach. This will embed skills and expertise in service and estates planning at a local level and include wider shared learning and practical solutions on innovative delivery models, estates optimisation and digital utilisation. This will provide an opportunity to test current planning assumptions and inform priorities using the Primary Care Toolkit and latest SHAPE Atlas data.
