



## Covid-19 vaccination: Briefing for stakeholders

Out-of-school vaccinations for children aged between 12 and 15-years-old have been taking place this week across Bath and North East Somerset, Swindon and Wiltshire.

Parents wishing to have their child vaccinated have been able to use the National Booking Service to arrange to their child's vaccination at the Steam Museum in Swindon, Salisbury City Hall or Bath Racecourse.

We have been delighted to see so many families come through the doors during this half term break, and we're expecting to have given out more than 4,400 vaccines by the end of this week.

Vaccinations will be available for children at these venues at weekends and on evenings throughout November, and will be carried out alongside Virgin Care' schools-based vaccine programme, which is due to resume on Monday.

### Advice for people booking a booster vaccination

Booster doses will be offered no earlier than six months (182 days) after the date of a person's last vaccination.

People who do not receive an invitation after this period should not worry, nor feel the need to contact their GP practice or local vaccination centre, as the online [National Booking Service](#) allows people without an invitation to book a booster vaccine once 190 days have passed since their last vaccination.

### New weekly walk-in clinics at the University of Bath

Students, uni staff and members of the public will be able to vaccinated without an appointment when a new weekly walk-in clinic at the University of Bath opens on Thursday 4 November.

Vaccines will be available between 11am and 4pm in the Sports Training Village.



If popular, the clinic will open on every Thursday during November.



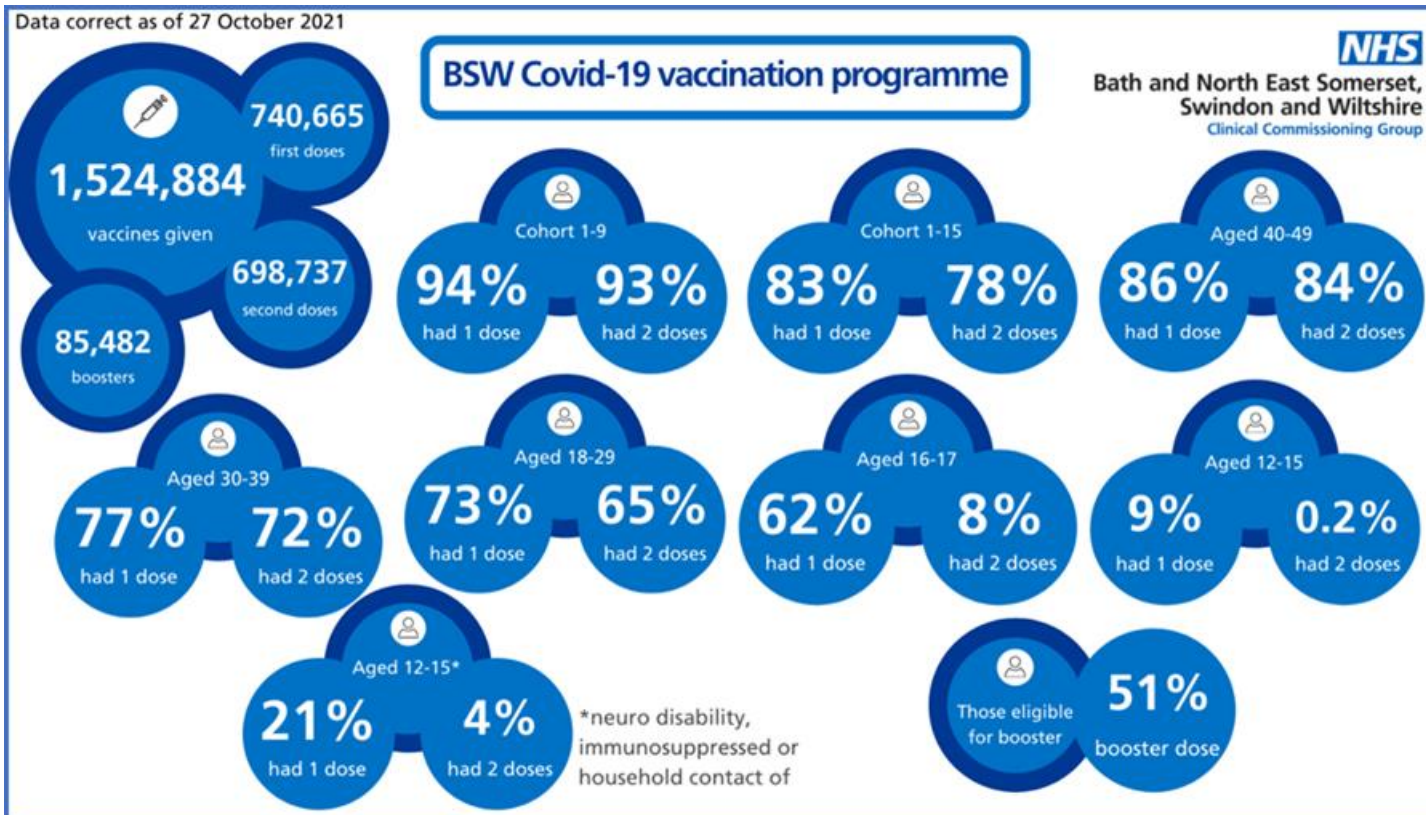
## Thousands reached through CCG's Facebook posts
