- We have received referrals from all localities within our catchment areas.
- There have been 97 referrals received since midday on 1st Sept, 31 of which were to Salisbury hospital.
- The system appears to be generally well received and working well.

FAB-TIA was developed pre-Covid and we discovered that some GP's working from home have been unable to access the system as they do not have access to the N3 Network. Referrals from these GP's will need to be made by the practice





Please be aware that Poole/Bournemouth and Salisbury are currently offering slightly different services.

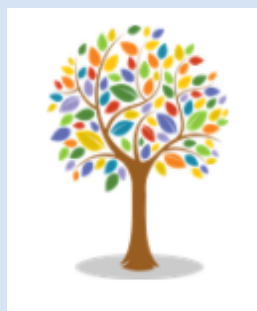
- All patients referred to **Salisbury** will need to attend in person at their appointment time
- All those referred to **Poole/Bournemouth** must be informed to **wait at home for a telephone consultation**, following which they may be asked to attend the hospital for further assessment /investigations
