Summary

- Pfizer are out of stock of Salazopyrin En-Tabs[®] until w/c 20 December 2021.
- Generic versions of sulfasalazine 500mg gastro-resistant tablets remain available.
- SPS MI have advised there are no known differences in bioavailability between the branded and generic products and they can be considered interchangeable.
- A Serious Shortage Protocol (SSP) was issued on 26/11/2021.

Actions Required

 For patients with insufficient supplies, community pharmacists may supply sulfasalazine gastroresistant 500mg tablets against the SSP for eligible patients.

If the above option is not deemed appropriate, clinicians should:

- consider prescribing sulfasalazine 500mg gastro-resistant tablets generically to enable any manufacturer's product to be dispensed; and
- counsel patients regarding the switch from branded to generic at the point of dispensing.
