Same Day Emergency Transport – pilot of extension of existing BaNES service delivered by F.A.S.T

For patients who meet the following criteria and need transport Monday to Friday' on the day or next day by an Ambulance are Assistant PTS Crew, to see a specialist at the hospital in an assessment unit at the RUH and GWH* only

(* If pilot service is expanded, then intention to roll out to SFT later in November)

Criteria

Patients:

 * BSW Registered CCG patient, or living within BSW geographical footprint

Conditions in scope for service:

- Falls
- Off legs
- UTI
- Previous diagnosed chronic illnesses ie dialysis, cancer

Conditions out of scope

- ACUTE Cardiac Conditions
- PE
- Septic Shock Symptoms
- Respiratory illnesses
- Epileptic seizures
- CVE

Objectives:

- * Reduce number of low acuity transport conveyance requests going to SWAST
- * Improve patients experience of waiting time for patients waiting for an ambulance
- * Timely assessment and diagnosis for patients and reducing number of overnight admissions to hospital
