

Same Day Emergency Transport – pilot of extension of existing BaNES service delivered by F.A.S.T

For patients who meet the following criteria and need transport Monday to Friday* on the day or next day by an Ambulance are Assistant PTS Crew, to see a specialist at the hospital in an assessment unit at the RUH and GWH* only
(* If pilot service is expanded, then intention to roll out to SFT later in November)

Criteria

Patients:

- * BSW Registered CCG patient, or living within BSW geographical footprint

Conditions in scope for service:

- Falls
- Off legs
- UTI
- Previous diagnosed chronic illnesses - ie dialysis, cancer

Conditions out of scope

- ACUTE Cardiac Conditions
- PE
- Septic Shock Symptoms
- Respiratory illnesses
- Epileptic seizures
- CVE

Objectives:

- * Reduce number of low acuity transport conveyance requests going to SWAST
- * Improve patients experience of waiting time for patients waiting for an ambulance
- * Timely assessment and diagnosis for patients and reducing number of overnight admissions to hospital
