## **NEWS FROM THE ALLIANCE**

- Feedback on our Prostate Cancer awareness campaign has been really positive and we want to
  extend our thanks to everyone who has helped spread the word so far. If you missed it; here is

- We have now reached an important stage in the development of the plans around establishing
  the TVCA RDS (rapid diagnostic services) pathways for lung and colorectal, and we would like to
  share plans and encourage colleagues to provide their feedback and suggestions on the plans.
   Clinical Advisory Group meetings to review the RDS pathways have been set up:
  - o Wednesday 9th December 3pm Lung CAG RDS review meeting. Chaired by Anny Sykes
  - o Tuesday 15th December 8am Colorectal CAG RDS review meeting. Chaired by David James

We will also be holding via a MS Teams a **one-hour RDS socialisation session** for each trust and CCG cancer leads. To be held between 7th – 18th December, invitations to follow. Optimal representation for each meeting would include clinician, diagnostic, operational, pathway managers, navigators and 2WW booking representation on the call. Invitations will be sent to Trust lead clinician and nurse to disseminate to teams.

There will be ongoing ways to feed into this ambitious 5year programme and if after any of the above meetings **you would like to become more directly involved** please do let us know as we will be looking for more trust and CCG representation within the enabling functions of the RDS models.   (RDC) programme as well as helping us shape an Alliance-wide Patient Reference Group. Patrick

  Oxford Research Centre and is a member of the Patient Advisory Panel at the Francis Crick
  Institute. He is also a representative for the South East, on the national Patient and Public Voice
  (PPV) forum.
- Trust PTL dashboards go live! We are very pleased to confirm that OUH went live with their Live interactive PTL dashboard this week, thanks to all the at OUH, Draper and Dash and TVCA for their commitment to delivering this. BHT and GWH are in final sign off, with MKUH to follow. Once all live feeds are established the TVCA data hub will then move to phase 2 with daily updates cancer activity across the alliance. We do look forward to working with all trusts to build out the added functionality within the RDS analytics and clinical pathway mapping portals in due course.
