- The Government has extended shielding guidance for clinically extremely vulnerable (CEV) people until 31st March 2021. The shielding advice remains the same as the guidance already in place for this group: CEV people are advised to stay at home unless for exercise or for healthcare appointments (including vaccination).
- NHS England open call for innovation in cancer care: SBRI Healthcare Cancer
 Programme: Competition 1. The NHS Cancer Programme is launching an open call for
 innovation in cancer care on 17 March. The funding competition of up to £15million,
 which will be delivered by NHS England and NHS Improvement in partnership with SBRI
 Healthcare Cancer Programme, will swiftly bring new and existing cancer care
